Key Term	Symbol	Definition
1. Notation		Visual Symbols for Sound
2. Treble Clef		A symbol at the start of the music to indicate the pitch (higher notes)
3. Stave		The 5 lines used to place musical notes
4. Scale		A series of notes played in ascending or descending order
5. Sharp		Raise the pitch of the note by a semitone (the black key to the right)
6. Flat		Lower the pitch of a note by a semitone (the black key to the left)
7. Semibreve		4-beat note (whole note)
8. Minim		2- beat note (half note)
9. Crotchet		1- beat note (quarter note)
10. Quaver		Half-beat note (eighth- note)
11. Rest (crotchet)		Pause/wait for one beat

12. Tone		A whole step between 2 notes, eg C-D
13. Semitone		A half step between 2 notes, the closest distance eg C-C#
14. Barline		The lines used to divide music into measures
15. Melody		The tune

Key Term	Symbol	Definition
1. Chord		2 or more notes played together
2. Triad		A 3-note chord
3. Ostinato		A repeated musical pattern
4. Loop		Cut and paste a musical idea so that it repeats
5. Drone		A note that is held/ sustained
6. Repetition		The same musical idea heard again
7. Phrase		A short musical sentence
8. Motif		A short musical idea , usually a few notes long (shorter than a phrase)
9. Leitmotif		A recurring motif which represents a character , idea or emotion.
10. Mickey-Mousing		In animation or film, where the music exactly copies the actions or gestures on screen.

Key Term	Definition
11. Diegetic	Sound that the characters on screen can hear eg talking or gunshots
12. Non-Diegetic	Sound that is added to the film, eg the underscore or soundtrack .
13. Major	A bright, happier sounding chord or key
14. Minor	A duller, sadder sounding chord or key
15. Dissonance	A clashing chord (notes close together)
16. Chromatic	Using the semitones, sharps and flats

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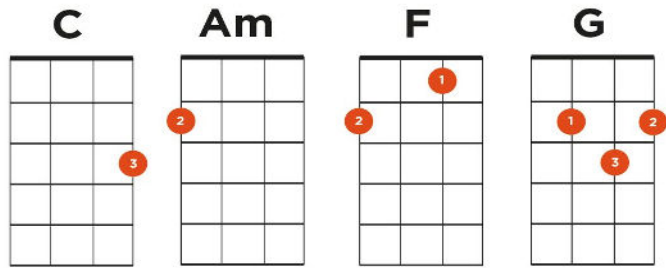

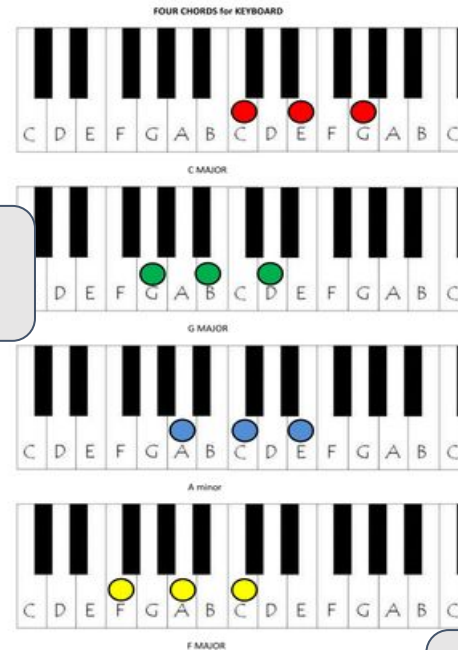

Key Term	Symbol	Definition
harmony		the combination of simultaneously sounded musical notes to produce a pleasing effect.
chord		two or more notes played at the same time to provide harmony
triad		a three note chord
major		a happy sounding harmony/chord
minor		a sad sounding harmony/ chord
broken chord		where each note of a chord is played in turn
keyboard		it is possible to play melody and harmony on a keyboard using more than one note at the same time

time signature		shows how many beats occur in each bar
bassline		a lower single line played at the same time as chords
melody		The tune - which usually has chords and/or bassline as an accompaniment
tempo		The speed of the music
